Mr Schrafft is a board member of the St George & Sutherland Community College. The conflict is less than significant as Mr Schrafft does not receive any direct or indirect benefit from the conversion of the existing at-grade pedestrian crossing to a raised pedestrian crossing. The conversion of the crossing is a safety issue for clients of the college and students from local schools.

2. A new report be prepared by Council's Traffic & Public Domain Services Unit for referral to the next meeting of the Sutherland Traffic & Traffic Safety Committee reviewing these revised parking time limit options.

STR123-18 **Gannons Rd, Caringbah - No Stopping restrictions north of Denman Avenue**

1. 30 metres of 'NO STOPPING' and 23 metres of 'NO STOPPING 6AM-10AM MON-FRI' be installed on the western side of Gannons Road, Caringbah, north of Denman Avenue, in accordance with Plan 'A' attached to the report; and
2. The Public Safety & Lifeguard Unit be informed of this decision for enforcement purposes.

STR124-18 **2019 Australia Day Special Event at Cronulla - Traffic and Transport Management**

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

That the traffic control measures for the 2019 Australia Day Special Event to be held on Saturday 26 January 2019 be endorsed, including:

1. Closing Gerrale Street car park, from 8pm Friday 25 January to 11pm Saturday 26 January 2019;
2. Temporary posting of 'NO PARKING 6AM-11PM 26 JAN' on the western side of Gerrale Street, between Laycock Avenue and the midblock pedestrian crossing, opposite Cronulla Park;
3. Traffic Control at Croydon Street car park, Cronulla in accordance with the Traffic Management Plan shown in Appendix 'A'; and
4. Controlling Traffic in Croydon Street, at Kingsway, Cronulla in accordance with the Traffic Management Plan shown in Appendix 'A';

STR125-18 **2019 Australia Day Celebrations Illawong - Temporary Bus Zone in Old Illawarra Road**

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. A 21 metre 'BUS ZONE 26 JAN' be installed on the southern side of Old Illawarra Road, approximately 100 metres east of Oriana Drive, Illawong; and
2. The Public Safety & Lifeguards Unit be advised of this decision for enforcement purposes.

STR126-18 **Parking Restrictions at Intersections in Areas Experiencing High Demand for Parking**

COMMITTEE REDOMMENDATION:

1. That the Sutherland Traffic and Traffic Safety Committee endorse the marking of yellow edge lines extending up to 10m into intersecting roads in areas experiencing high demand for parking and up to 15m into intersecting roads where Council's Traffic Engineers consider edge lines to be warranted in order restrict parking as necessary to ensure the free flow of traffic at intersections.
2. The above recommendation is subject to a 6 month trial period with a report to be provided to the Consultative Traffic Forum after 3 months from the start of the trial. The report is to provide maps showing areas where lines extending up to 10m into intersecting roads have been marked and drawings where lines extending over 10 metres into intersecting roads have been marked.

STR127-18 **Dianella Street carpark, Caringbah - 15 Minute parking**

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. Four parking spaces of '¼P 7.30AM-9.30AM 2.30AM-5.30PM MON-FRI' be installed in Dianella Reserve car park, Caringbah, in accordance with Plan 'A' attached to the report; and
2. The Public Safety & Lifeguards Unit be advised of this decision for enforcement purposes.

STR128-18 **Surf Lane, Cronulla - Construction management**

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. The following temporary changes to parking controls be implemented in Surf Lane, between Beach Park Avenue and Surf Road, Cronulla, for a period of twelve months, in accordance with Plan 'A' attached to the report:
 - Convert the existing 24 metre '2P 8.30AM-6PM MON-FRI 8.30AM-12.30PM SAT' zone on the western side of Surf Lane to a 15 metre 'WORKS ZONE 7AM-6PM MON-FRI 8AM-3PM SAT' and 9 metre 'NO PARKING' zone;
 - Convert the existing 10 metre 'LOADING ZONE 6AM-6PM MON-FRI 6AM-3PM SAT', 9 metre 'NO PARKING' zone and 13 metre 'LOADING ZONE 6AM-6PM MON-FRI 6AM-3PM SAT' on the eastern side of Surf Lane to an 11.4 metre '1P 8.30AM-6PM MON-FRI 8.30AM-12.30PM SAT' zone, 20 metre 'LOADING ZONE 6AM-6PM MON-FRI 6AM-3PM SAT' and 8.5 metre 'NO STOPPING' zone; and
2. The Public Safety and Lifeguard Unit be informed of this decision for enforcement purposes.

STR129-18 **2018/2019 Sydney Sprint Series Triathlon - Kurnell**

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

STR130-18 **Holts Point Place, off Belgrave Esplanade, Sylvania - Parking Review**

3. Council's Public Safety and Lifeguards Unit be advised of these decisions for enforcement purposes.

General Business

- Councillor Greg McLean requested a review of the 'No Parking' signage recently installed outside Bundeena RSL Club. Representatives from the club have asked for reconsideration of the signage to either reduce the 'No Parking' area or to provide an exception for parking of the club's bus. Mario Sherrie advised that Traffic & Public Domain Services will contact the club to discuss solutions and develop a proposal.
- Mr Michael Cutrupi briefed the Committee regarding a matter previously raised concerning the proposal to install a 'No right turn – taxis & buses accepted' sign at the intersection of Hay Avenue and Kingsway, Caringbah. Mr Cutrupi advised that the Taxi Council are in agreement with this proposal. Mr Mark Carruthers advised that Roads & Maritime Services are still investigating options at this location.
- Mr Tony Blain requested follow up information on a previous matter raised concerning the provision of registration data (suburb of registration) for users of the parking areas along Rawson Avenue and the Sutherland Leisure Centre carpark. Mario Sherrie will follow up on obtaining this data.
