STR044-19 2020 Australia Day Special Event at Cronulla - Traffic and Transport Management

 - Temporarily closing Gerrale Street car park adjacent Cronulla Park, from 8pm Saturday 25 January to 11pm Sunday 26 January 2020;
 - Temporary installing 'NO PARKING 6AM-11PM 26 JAN' on the western side of Gerrale Street, between Laycock Avenue and the midblock pedestrian crossing, opposite Cronulla Park;
 - Temporarily control traffic at the Croydon Street council free car park, Cronulla; and
 - Temporarily control traffic at the Croydon Street intersection with Kingsway, Cronulla; subject to the Conditions listed in the report.
