General Business:

1. Tanmila Samin Islam (representing Roads & Maritime Services) provided an update regarding General Business Item 1, from the Consultative Traffic Forum meeting held on 4 October 2019, regarding the Loading Zone and Taxi Zone in Kingsway, opposite Caringbah Train Station.
2. Team Leader Traffic & Transport Services (Greg Holding) presented feedback from a resident of Burraneer Bay regarding vehicle lane recognition at the intersection of Kingsway, President Avenue, Port Hacking Road and Mackay Street, Caringbah and the potential for the current linemarking layout to be confusing to autonomous vehicles.

Tanmila Samin Islam (representing Roads & Maritime Services) advised that RMS is not in favour of the suggested changes because:

- Converting the eastbound approach lane configuration in Kingsway as suggested by the resident is too inefficient.
- Although they may appear intuitive on a plan, RMS believes that the proposed additional turning lines would be more confusing for drivers.
- Linemarking standardised across all traffic lights in NSW, with different linemarking for different purposes, and the suggested changes would need to be considered across the wider network.

Tanmila advised that RMS will continue to monitor and investigate improvements to the intersection.
