STR055-19 Gerrale Street, Cronulla - Pedestrian Crossing

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

An at-grade pedestrian crossing be installed in Gerrale Street, south of Ocean Grove Avenue, Cronulla, for a three month trial period, in accordance with *PLAN B* tabled at the meeting.

STR056-19 Port Hacking Road, Caringbah - Pedestrian Crossing South of Mansfield Avenue

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. The 'NO STOPPING' on the western side of Port Hacking Road, south of the pedestrian crossing at Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah, be extended, in accordance with *PLAN A* attached to the report;
2. The Bus Stop and 'BUS ZONE' on the eastern side of Port Hacking Road, south of the Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah, be relocated approximately 50 metres to the south, and convert the existing 'BUS ZONE' to 30 minute parking, in accordance with *PLAN A* attached to the report;
3. The parallel parking spaces in Port Hacking Road and Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah, be linemarked, in accordance with *PLAN A*, *PLAN B* and *PLAN C* attached to the report;
4. Painted traffic islands, a 'GIVE WAY' sign and associated linemarking and 'FORM 1 LANE' sign be installed on the eastern side of Port Hacking Road, at Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah, in accordance with *PLAN D* attached to the report;
5. Relocating the Australia Post street posting box and associated 'MAIL ZONE' on the eastern side of Port Hacking Road, north of Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah be further investigated;
6. Constructing a kerb extension on the western side of Port Hacking Road, at the pedestrian crossing south of Mansfield Avenue, Caringbah, be scoped and costed for inclusion on a future works program; and
7. The Public Safety & Lifeguards Unit be advised of Council's decision for enforcement purposes.

**STR057-19 Minor Signposting and Linemarking - December 2019

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. The signage and linemarking measures listed in *Table 1* in the report be approved, in accordance with Plans E2-4 & C2-5 attached to the report; and subject to:
 - i. Plan E1 not having signposted 'Work Zone'; and
 - ii. Withdrawing Plan C1, pending further investigation by Transport NSW and Council staff; and
2. The Public Safety & Lifeguards Unit be advised of Council's decision for enforcement purposes.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Councillor McLean raised the issue of lack of pedestrian and bike access between Loftus Station precinct and Royal National Park. Greg Holding advised that Council staff will discuss possible options with Roads & Maritime Services and National Parks & Wildlife Service.
2. Councillor McLean raised the issue of lack of a pedestrian crossing in Porter Street, at Engadine High School. Greg Holding advised that Council staff will investigate the matter during School Term 1 of 2020.

3. Sanjana Dev advised that Transdev is investigating diverting one bus of the M92 Bus Route to better accommodate Menai High School.
4. Constable Scott Robinson requested that Council investigate providing 'KEEP CLEAR' pavement markings in Glencoe Street at the driveway for Sutherland Police Station. Greg Holding advised that Council staff will investigate the matter.
5. *** Tony Blain declared a not significant non-pecuniary interest ***

Tony Blain requested that Council provides Committee members with a copy of the previously tabled concept plans for the off-street parking proposed for Mill Creek bike trails. Greg Holding advised that he will provide further advice on the matter.

Councillor Croucher vacated the Chair and left the meeting at 10:42am and did not return.

The Deputy Chairperson, Councillor McLean, assumed the Chair (10:42am).

6. Greg Holding briefed the Committee on bus services and bus stop locations for Bundeena and Royal National Park, including the following advice:
 - The Royal National Park bus services will commence shortly, with Council providing drop-off/pick-up points at the existing Bus Zones in East Parade, Sutherland and Loftus Street, Bundeena.
 - Following community consultation, Council staff will convene an electronic meeting to endorse the installation of a 'No Parking' zone in Bundeena, near the Coast Track trail head.
 - Following further discussions with the Bus Operator, Council staff will commence consultation with the Bundeena community regarding formalised Bus Stops in Bundeena and Royal National Park.
