RECOMMENDATION:

THAT:

1. The Consultative Traffic Committee expressed concerns with potential conflict between resident overflow parking and parking for sporting activities. In the interests of maintaining an appropriate level of service for the sporting organisations, spectators and participants it is proposed the parking restrictions noted in the report as 'point 2' be amended as follows:
  2. *Council will impose a ~~4P restriction between 6am and 6pm Saturday and Sunday~~ 2P restriction from 6am to 9am and 4P restriction from 9am to 8pm Saturdays and Sundays in Council car parks on each side of Captain Cook Drive.*
  
2. The weekday parking restrictions as noted in point 3 in the body of the report (*Council will impose a 2P restriction between 3pm and 10pm Monday to Friday in Council car parks on each side of Captain Cook Drive*) are endorsed by the committee as proposed.
