#### **AGEING POPULATION**

The Sutherland Shire has an ageing population, with 23% of the population aged over 60 years. By 2036 this group is anticipated to increase 26% – representing a 53% increase in the 85+ year age group and 56% increase in the 70-84 year age group.

#### **ACTIVE AGEING**

We want all people in the Sutherland Shire to live more vibrant, healthy, active and happy lives as they age by creating a local environment that supports our seniors to live longer and better than ever before.

We recognise our seniors community is constantly changing. We strive to focus on enhancing health and wellbeing by enabling seniors to come together, participate and engage with the local community supporting them to stay informed, build resilience and better navigate and negotiate change.

Facilitating active ageing through building strong connections, encouraging early life-planning, and ensuring there are facilities and services available for older residents are important factors in maintaining an engaged, inclusive, caring and supportive community.

Council understands the importance of providing information, resources, services, programs and facilities that provide for active and healthy ageing, with the aim for older residents to maintain



independence over important decisions that can affect the quality of their lives.

# SUTHERLAND SHIRE COUNCIL'S 'ACTIVE AGEING' REPORT CARD 2020-2022'

The Sutherland Shire Active Ageing Sector Plan (2018-22) plans for the needs of an ageing population. Developed in consultation with residents, service providers and community organisations, it sets out actions that provide for an active, healthy and engaged community.

#### **COUNCIL'S KEY ACHIEVEMENTS (2020-2022):**

- More than \$31 million worth of rate rebates for Pensioners.
- √ \$8.75 million in subsidies to local community organisations servicing older residents.
- Actively promoted volunteering with council and local community organisations.
- Regularly engaged with service providers and older residents to understand changing needs and ensure representation.
- ✓ Upgraded to a new accessible audio/visual system in Council Chambers enabling automatic connection for people using hearing aids, providing audio recordings of each Council meeting
- ✓ Collaborative partnerships with service providers to support healthy active ageing, early life-planning and independent choice for older people.
- ✓ More than \$1 million in grants for projects/programs involving older people.
- ✓ More than \$200,000 in grants for projects/programs involving older people
- ✓ Dedicated staff providing information, resources, referrals and support to older residents, including website and the Seniors Services Directory.
- ✓ Events and activities for more than 137,000 older residents, including; Seniors Festival, Healthy Ageing seminars, programs at leisure centres, talks and activities at libraries, and events at Sutherland Entertainment Centre
- ✓ Provided engagement and inclusive programs for people with disability and people with lived experience of dementia at Hazelhurst Arts Centre. Including Unpacking Dementia workshops in collaboration with the St George & Sutherland Shire Dementia Alliance and a Memory Café event held online for people with dementia and their carers.
- ✓ Libraries and Community Services are providing Auslan interpreter services at their key events.
- ✓ Home Library Services deliver to any community member with format and content tailored to customer preferences and assistance is provided to use technology to access content.

- ✓ More audio book options available so book groups can be more inclusive of people with low vision and introduced free usage of internet access on public computers at our Sutherland Shire Libraries.
- ✓ The 2015 Development Control Plan requires 10% liveable housing and 20% adaptable housing provision in new multi-dwelling developments and residential flat buildings.
- ✓ The Housing Strategy 2020 2014-2031 provides actions to enhance appropriate housing for an ageing population, including incentives for villa developments and promoting dual occupancy dwellings.
- ✓ Accessibility considerations have been made for the Cronulla Masterplan and the Sutherland Entertainment Centre.
- Masterplan for Cooper Street Reserve, Engadine includes an all abilities playground.
- ✓ Supported residential aged care places in Sutherland Shire to exceed Australian Government benchmarks.
- ✓ Nine new accessible drop-off zones near shopping/ medical centres for private and community transport improving access for people with limited mobility.
- ✓ Information sessions and resources provided for My Aged Care, getting help at home and residential aged care including this updated Sutherland Shire Seniors Directory.
- Support programs recognising the important role of carers supporting older people in the community.
- ✓ Information sessions, training and support resources provided for those with dementia their families and carers and aged care service providers.
- ✓ More than \$2.6 million spent on footpath upgrades to enhance accessibility.
- ✓ More than \$150,000 spent on ramp and pedestrian facility upgrades to enhance accessibility around shopping centres and schools.
- ✓ Upgrades creating more accessible parks, reserves and playgrounds at Barden Ridge, Parc Menai, Casandra Crescent Reserve, Corea Street Reserve, Cronulla Park and Oak Park

Council has achieved many outcomes and is committed to providing support services, information, resources, programs and facilities that meet the changing and different needs of our older community.

- Delivered on Council's commitment to providing accessible facilities that enable everyone in our community to maintain a healthy and active lifestyle by installing outdoor gym equipment at six parks/reserves. This fixed-to-ground exercise equipment includes sit-up benches, chin-up bars and balance beams, and caters for people of all ages and abilities.
- ✓ Enhanced access to Leisure Centre pools for people with disability, including online virtual classes. Accessible beaches program included over \$30,000 of accessibility improvements for Cronulla Beach in partnership with St Vincent de Paul, including new electric and beach wheelchairs and Mobi Mat enhancing access to Cronulla Beach for people of all abilities.
- A new Toilet Program has seen upgrades of 10 public toilets including upgrading accessibility standards.
- Accessibility considerations have been made for the Cronulla Masterplan and the Sutherland Entertainment Centre
- ✓ The Cronulla Esplanade upgrade will provide a continuous graded pathway, removing mobility barriers and provide accessible seating
- Community Centres and Halls have been assessed, with many upgraded to enhance accessibility.
- ✓ 2015 Liveable Communities Workshops involving residents, community groups and government aimed to ensure our built environment, infrastructure, housing, services and social spaces are accessible by all. Workshops highlighted the need for multi-generational planning for safe walkable neighbourhoods, availability of local

- services, opportunities for community engagement, and affordable, appropriate housing.
- ✓ The 2022-26 Disability Inclusion Action Plan aims
  to support the rights of people with disabilities and
  enhance access and inclusion, so that people with
  disability can participate equally and meaningfully
  in the community. 2018 2022 Active Ageing
  Sector Plan includes feedback from the residents,
  service providers and the community to inform
  council's community services and promote what
  residents can do to provide for healthy active
  ageing.
- ✓ The Economic Development Strategy aims to Increase the number of local jobs by 10,000 FTE by 2030. In addition advocate to the Central & Eastern Sydney Primary Health Network and the Greater Sydney Commission to explore opportunities for increased specialisms in health services (ie cardiac, mental health, geriatric medicine, obesity) and proactively market the Sutherland Shire as a location of choice to conduct professional, scientific and technical services and health care and social assistance services.
- ✓ Development of an Open Space and Recreation Strategy to increase participation in physical and recreation activities leading to improved health and wellbeing.
- ✓ The 2020-30 Community Development Strategy aims to facilitate healthy, connected, caring, inclusive, resilient and liveable communities. Its purpose is to provide for the social wellbeing of the community by ensuring there are services, programs and facilities that support and enable all – including promoting healthy active ageing through development of an Age-Friendly Community.

# CARE AND SUPPORT

Sutherland Shire has a vibrant, diverse and active community of older people. Sometimes people require care and support in order to maintain their independence, remain living in their own home and be involved and active in the community.

Family and friends can perform caring roles but sometimes need a helping hand, and that is where care and support services can assist.

My Aged Care is an Australian Government website and phone line to help find and access aged care services.

My Aged Care provides in-home and community care services to eligible older people. Help at home can include putting in rails or ramps, transport to medical appointments or social activities, support cleaning or bathing, meals, social activities, and respite for carers.

If you require additional help at home or have complex needs, then you may be eligible for a personalised Home Care Package.

Residential Aged Care Homes (nursing homes) are for those that need more help with day-to-day tasks or health care.

Active ageing well is about being prepared, having choice and flexibility. Being informed about the range of support services available can be of benefit should you ever need to access them.

Sutherland Shire is fortunate to have a range of services that can help you to maintain your independence, health and wellbeing. Getting help is just a phone call away.

The Carer Gateway is a national on-line and regional service which provides practical information and resources to support carers. As a carer, you may be eligible to access a wide range of help - from counselling, coaching sessions, peer support groups, short-term services and emergency respite.

# **NAVIGATING 'MY AGED CARE'**

# LEVELS OF CARE AND SUPPORT

#### **BASIC HELP AT HOME**

If you need some support to help you in the home you may be eligible to access basic services under the Commonwealth Home Support Programme.

#### **HOME CARE PACKAGES**

If you require additional help at home or have complex needs you may require a personalised Home Care Package. Home Care Packages provide a coordinated package of care, services and case management to meet individual needs.

# RESIDENTIAL AGED CARE HOME

If you find you need ongoing help with day-to-day tasks or health care, a residential aged care home lets you live in a supported environment where help is available. This may be permanent or for respite care.

  - C. choose package provider
  - D. receive services

#### **RESIDENTIAL AGED CARE**

- Have a comprehensive face-to-face assessment by Aged Care Assessment Team (approval for entry to a Government approved aged care home)
  - A. contact providers
  - B. find out about the facilities, care and services offered, requirements, fees, conditions and agreements
  - C. choose an aged care home
  - D. receive services

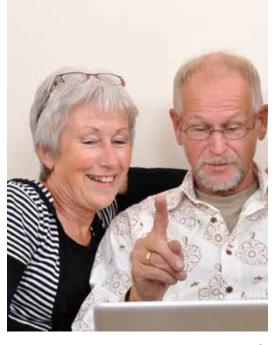
#### SERVICES PROVIDED AT HOME

- Domestic help e.g. cleaning, laundry
- Transport e.g. appointments, shopping and activities
- Home modifications e.g. handrails, ramps
- · Home maintenance e.g. gardening, minor repairs
- Meals e.g. delivered to your home, help making meals
- · Personal care e.g. help dressing, bathing, toileting, mobility
- Equipment e.g. walking frames, shower
- Social support eg. social groups, activities
- Short-term help after an accident. injury or illness; or you want to get your independence back after a setback e.g. after a hospital stay
- Respite care e.g. short-term care when you or your carer need a break
- Nursing and other care e.g. medication management, wound dressing, continence management
- · Allied Health Care e.g. physiotherapy, podiatry, occupational therapy, dietician
- Assistive technology, aids or equipment e.g. to help with mobility, communication, personal safety

# SERVICES PROVIDED IN AN **AGED CARE HOME**

- Day-to-day tasks (e.g. cleaning, cooking and meals, laundry)
- Personal care (e.g. dressing, grooming, toileting, mobility, communication)
- 24-hour nursing care (e.g. wound care, catheter care)
- · Social activities, both in-house and in the community
- Accommodation of cultural and religious beliefs
- Emergency health assistance

They range from small playgrounds that cater for local residents and often for a specific age group, through to regional 'destination' playgrounds with multiple types of equipment and designed for longer visits. #### Accessible features in upgraded playgrounds in 2020 and 2021

The majority of our renewed playgrounds have a small bike path/scooter path around the perimeter of the playgrounds. The new play equipment was designed with enhanced access features to align with the State Government Policy, 'Everyone can Play'.

#### **Bonna Point Reserve**

Accessible footpaths from the car park to the playground, including an accessible amenities block.

There is ample room for large gatherings to play ball sports and to picnic in the reserve with new landscaping, bench seating and other public amenities.

#### **Burnum Burnum Sanctuary**

Accessible play equipment includes inground trampolines and carousel with level paths and synthetic grass softfall to facilitate wheelchairs with a walking path around the playground.

#### **Cassandra Crescent, Heathcote**

The park and playground was upgraded in December 2020 with a focus on all-abilities play. The play equipment includes a ramp to the upper deck so less mobile children can gain access and join in the play.

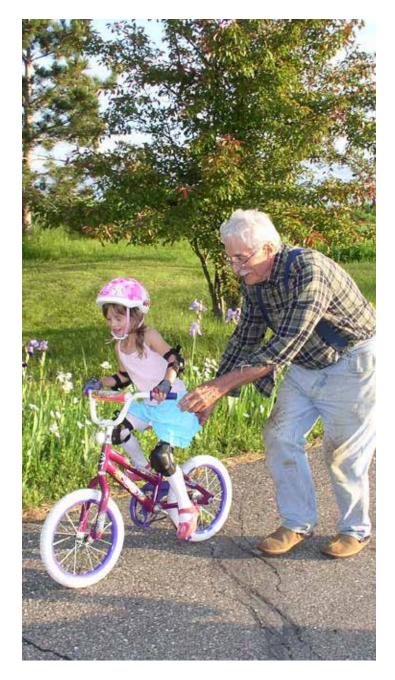
The play area has synthetic grass pathways through the middle providing better access for wheelchair users. Pram ramps and new paths at the entry provide all-abilities access around the entire reserve.

### Kalang Lane Reserve, Yowie Bay

Children can ride their bikes and scooters on the path around the playground, which doubles as a walking track. Synthetic softfall provides accessibility for wheelchairs.

New static bars fitness equipment has been installed in the Reserve for a variety of ages and fitness levels. With seating, water and bottle fill station, and lots of level grass, Kalang Lane Reserve is a perfect place to run around or enjoy a picnic or family gathering.

The amenities block has been upgraded and is fully accessible.



## Sandy Point Reserve

The playground was comprehensively renewed in 2021 with new equipment and undersurfacing and updated picnic facilities and seating.

The playground features state-ofthe-art play equipment with a double storey tower, a double slide and a new connecting timber "play bridge" that joins to the existing giant nest swing.

Synthetic grass runs throughout most of the playground, providing accessible play opportunities.

## **HOUSING**

As people get older, housing needs can change. Some people wish to stay in their family home, others want to downsize to a smaller house, villa or unit.

There's also the option of moving to a retirement village with medical services and social opportunities on site.

People requiring greater support may consider residential aged care. There are steps involved to enter residential aged care and it is preferable for people to plan ahead and research their options to make sure their choices are met.

Deciding where to live as you get older is a major decision needing careful thought: you need to consider the costs involved, location, closeness of family members or carers, and support services available.

#### What are my options?

If you can live independently, there's a variety of in-home and community care services you can access for support so you can stay in your home (see Care and Support section).

If you need additional care and support services now, you may consider residential aged care for respite or on a more permanent basis.

#### What should I know?

Whatever you decide there are important legal, social and financial issues you need to know, understand and agree to before signing an agreement, lease or contract.

## STEPS FOR MOVING TO A RESIDENTIAL AGED CARE FACILITY

Residential aged care can assist those who can no longer live at home due to illness, disability, bereavement or emergency, respite, or simply because residential aged care suits their changing needs. Facilities can help with day-to-day living, such as cleaning, cooking, laundry, personal care, medical and nursing care, and offer a range of social and recreational activities.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

You must undertake a free assessment of your care needs by an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) to enter into an aged care home - call 1800 200 422. After the assessment you will be given a letter if you are approved as eligible for subsidised aged care services.

## FINDING AN AGED CARE HOME

My Aged Care will provide you with the contact details of aged care homes in different locations via the Aged Care Home Finder. Contact the homes you are interested in and ask for information about their fees, services and facilities. The best way to be sure a home suits your needs is to visit and compare homes yourself. Make sure you make a list of all your requirements and bring your ACAT letter. Talk to your family, or carers who may be assisting you, about your requirements and wishes for an aged care home.

#### **FEES AND CHARGES**

The Government subsidises residential aged care, however aged care residents are expected to contribute towards the cost of their care according to their means. There are fees charged for care, accommodation and daily living costs. You will need to go to the Department of Human Services (Centrelink) to undertake a means-tested assessment of your combined income and assets. You should ask aged care facilities to provide you with a complete list of fees in writing, along with any information on payment dates and plans they may offer. You can contact My Aged Care to help estimate the fees and charges you may have to pay towards residential aged care - this is recommended before negotiating or signing any agreements.

### APPLYING FOR AN AGED **CARE HOME**

You can apply for as many homes as you like and when a place is available they will contact you. After accepting a place at a home you will need to fill in an application form that will be specific to the facility. You will need to fill in an income and asset assessment form with Centrelink and will then be asked to sign an agreement with the aged care home.

#### RESIDENT AGREEMENT

As each aged care home is different, each agreement will be different. Agreements are legally binding and cover services, fees, rights and responsibilities, and when you could be asked to leave. Make sure you fully understand all of the components and conditions in the agreement before signing it. You can request some advice from a lawyer, My Aged Care, Legal Aid NSW or Seniors Rights Service if something in the agreement is unclear to you.

## **TRANSPORT**

Travelling easily to the services and facilities you need and enjoy is vital to remaining independent and active as you get older.

Sutherland Shire has good public transport, including trains, ferries, buses and private taxis. All can accommodate people with limited mobility.

Activus Transport (Community Transport) is available for eligible older residents to provide individual or group transport to medical appointments, shopping, social activities, and more.

Wheelchair accessible taxis can be booked in advance and on a regular basis. Reduced travel rates for eligible people with a severe disability are available through the Taxi Transport Subsidy Scheme.

Mobility scooters are convenient for short trips. Check with the Roads and Maritime Services about regulations to help you decide if this transport will suit you.

Mobility aids such as walking sticks, walkers and wheelchairs can assist those with limited mobility to keep active.

Walking or cycling are great alternatives and have the benefit of maintaining good health and fitness. There are many cycleways, bush walking and gentle walking tracks in Sutherland Shire.



## **MOTOR VEHICLES**

You can attend driver training and skills testing to help you keep up to date with road rules and retain your licence for as long as possible. Roads and Maritime Services may at times require older drivers to have regular medical or eyesight tests or sit a driving test; you can also speak to your GP about any concerns. 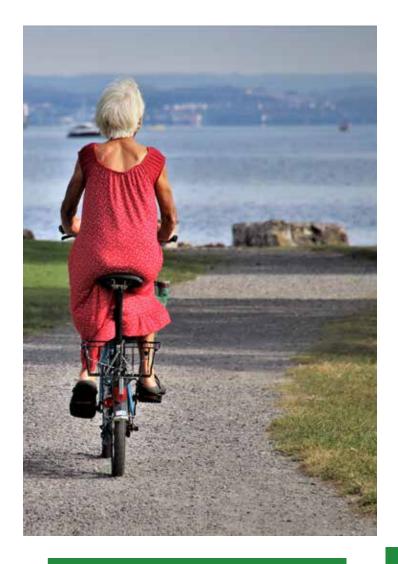

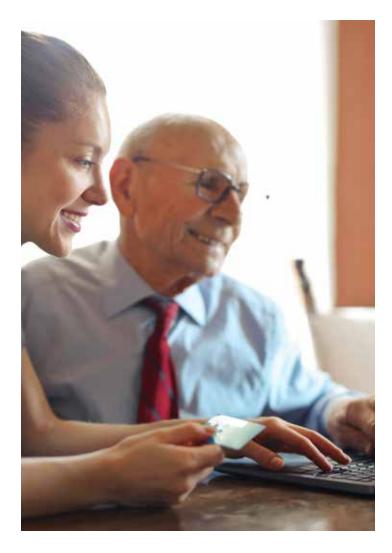
