# Materials

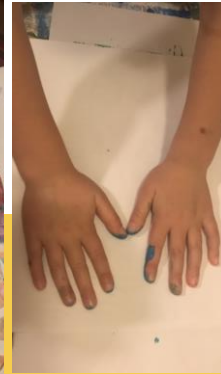
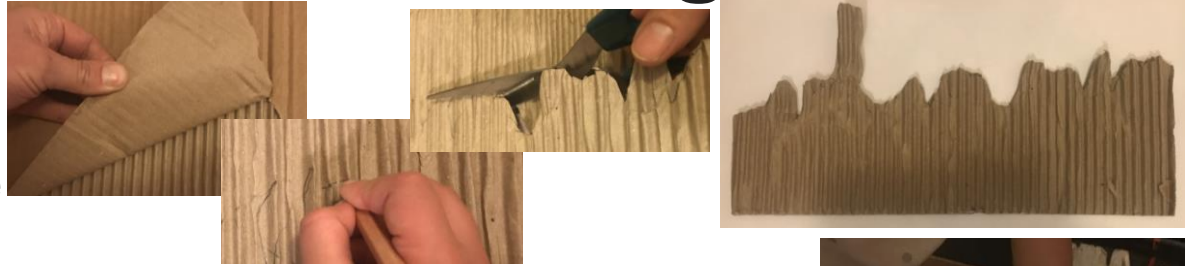
**your materials can be different, your artwork will be original to you!**

- Paper for your card
- Pencils
- Scissors
- Brushes
- Paints
- Cardboard
- Glue
- Coloured wool



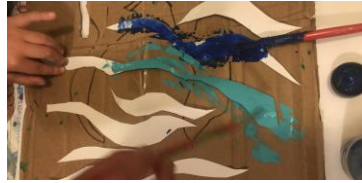
# Printing the Seaweed Background

- Tear off the top layer of the cardboard.
- Cut along a line in the shape of the seaweed.
- Paint the corrugated card green (use quite a lot of paint).
- While the paint is still wet lay your paper on top of the green and press down firmly.
- Lift the paper off, the green should have printed on the paper



# Printing the Waves

- Cut some wavy shapes out of paper.
- Paint them blue.
- While still wet, lay them face down on the seaweed.
- Press down firmly and peel off.
- For added waves you can stick the blue strips on top of the printed waves.



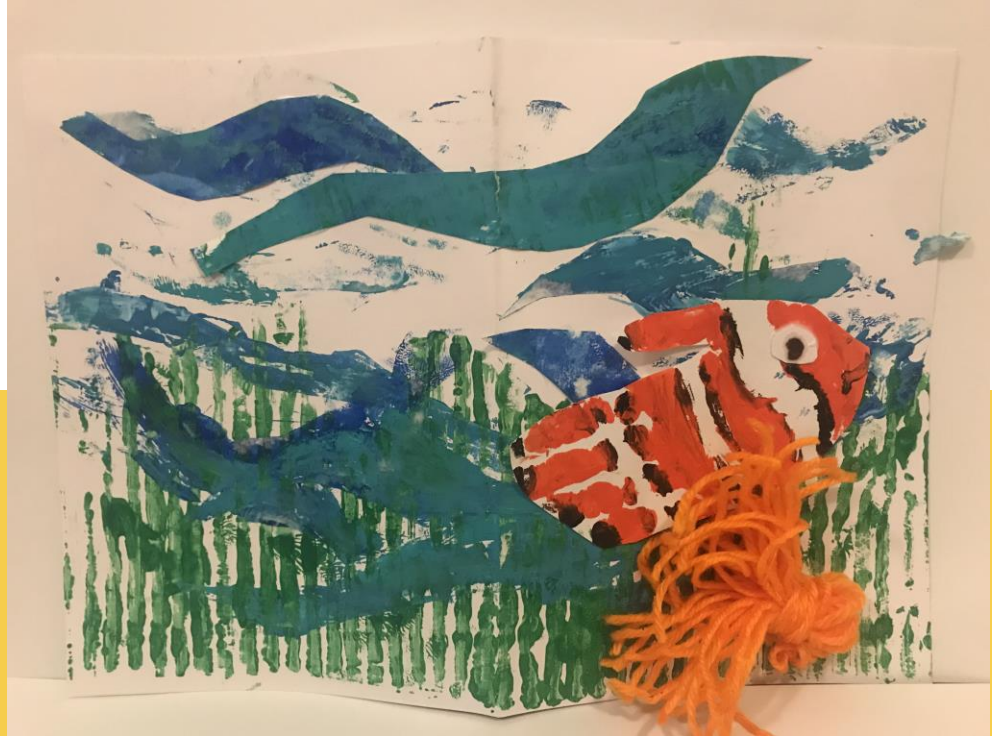
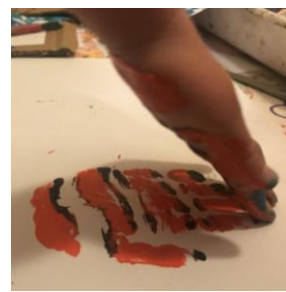
# Attach the Sea Anemone

- Wrap colourful wool around your hand.
- Tie it together at one end.
- Cut the loops at the other end.
- Glue it to your card in position (leaving space for fish to hide behind).



# Printing your fish

- Paint the palm of your hand stripy like a clown fish (use water soluble, non-toxic paint).
- While the paint is wet, press onto a fresh piece of paper.
- Cut out with scissors.
- Add the eye and mouth.
- Stick onto the card behind the sea anemone.
