The 'Zero Litter in Georges River' Georges Riverkeeper project won the award in the Litter Prevention/Clean Waterways category.

Sutherland Shire Council, a member of Georges Riverkeeper and host to the organisation, led the project research about Gross Pollutant Trap (GPT) performance. GPTs prevent waste from entering waterways. We helped develop a best-practice guide for GPT Planning, Design, and Procurement, intended for use by all Councils to address these challenges.

The program also saw involvement from more than 500 children including students at Como Public School.

### DRAFT OVERLAND FLOOD STUDY

Council has prepared a draft Overland Flood Study for a large proportion of the Sutherland Shire.

This study will allow us to identify risks associated with floods of various sizes, ensuring the safety of our buildings, assets, and most importantly, our residents. Thanks to advanced modelling, we now have a clearer understanding of floodwater behaviour and overland flow.

Knowing the flood risks to your property means you can create a personalised flood response plan to protect yourself and minimise damage during floods. View the draft study and provide feedback that helps shape our community's flood management strategies.

Tree cuttings must be no more than 250mm in diameter and cuttings with sharp thorns or spikes cannot be accepted.

You can even take a load of mulch home with you when you bring a bucket (no bags). The woodchipper will not be onsite on the day.
