

WHERE CAN I TAKE MY DOG IN KURNELL?

DOG PROHIBITED AREAS

Dogs are not allowed in the following areas at any time. Penalties apply for non-compliance.

- Kamay Botany Bay National Park
- Silver Beach
- All Bonna Point Foreshore Reserves and Beaches (this area is a bird sanctuary for the protection of endangered bird species)

KURNELL DOG BEACH

- This is the only permitted off-leash area in Kurnell

OFF-LEASH AREA RULES

- All dogs must be accompanied and supervised by a competent person.
- All dogs must be able to be controlled without a leash, e.g., return to handler on command.
- Maximum of four (4) dogs per person.
- Dog walkers must remove all dog faeces that may be deposited by a dog under their control.
- Dog walkers are liable under the Companion Animals Act if their dog rushes at or attacks any person or animal (other than vermin).

ON-LEASH AREA RULES

Dogs are allowed on-leash in all public spaces, footways and reserves unless otherwise sign posted. Note this does not include National Park areas.

- Dogs must be under effective control by way of leash or cord by a competent person.
- Dogs must not rush at, or attack any person or animal (other than vermin).
- Dogs must not be within 10 meters of children's play equipment at any time.
- Dog walkers must pick up any faeces deposited by their dog immediately.

TOWRA POINT AQUATIC RESERVE (SANCTUARY ZONE)
