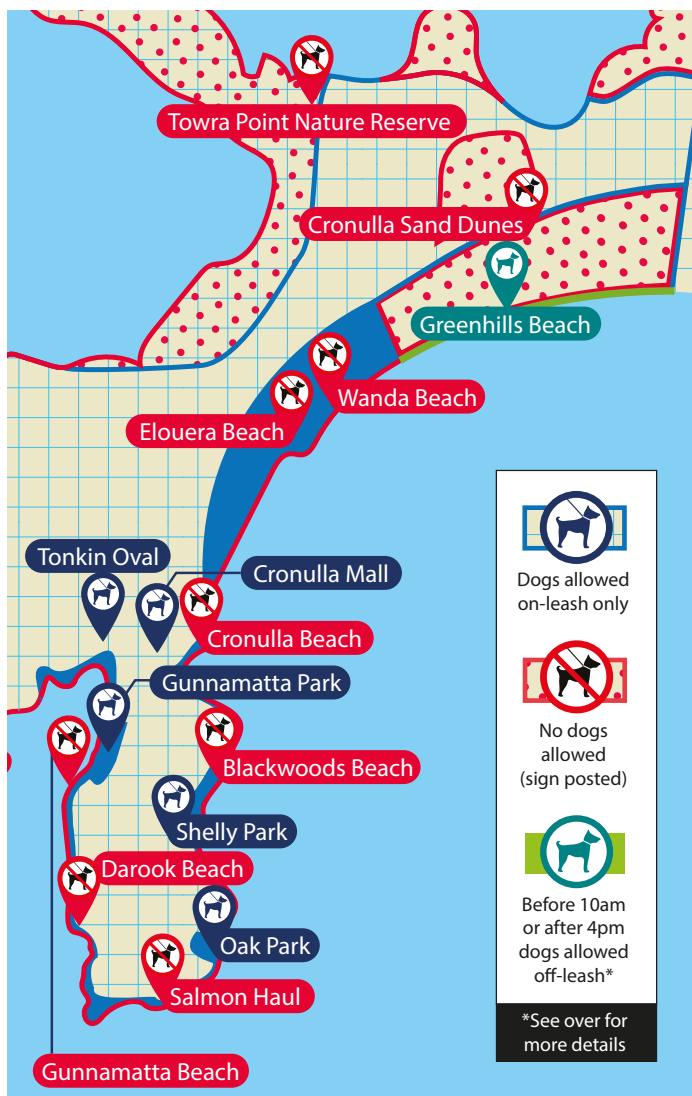


WHERE CAN I TAKE MY DOG IN CRONULLA?

Responsibilities for a person in control of a dog as per the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998.

DOG PROHIBITED AREAS

Dogs are not allowed in the following areas at any time. Penalties apply for non-compliance.

- ☒ All public beaches and waterfrontages in Cronulla (except Greenhills Beach at the set times)
- ☒ Darook Park Reserve
- ☒ Cronulla Sand Dunes
- ☒ Towra Point Nature Reserve (NPWS)

GREENHILLS BEACH

This is the only permitted off-leash area in Cronulla.

Summer (Daylight Savings)

- ☒ No dogs allowed from 10am to 4pm
- ☒ Dogs allowed off-leash from 4pm to 10am

Winter (Standard Time)

- ☒ No dogs allowed from 10am to 3pm
- ☒ Dogs allowed off-leash from 3pm to 10am

GREENHILLS BEACH OFF-LEASH RULES

- All dogs must be accompanied and supervised by a competent person.
- All dogs must be able to be controlled without a leash, e.g., return to handler on command.
- Maximum of four (4) dogs per person.
- Dog walkers must remove all dog faeces that may be deposited by a dog under their control.
- Dog walkers are liable under the Companion Animals Act if their dog rushes at or attacks any person or animal (other than vermin).

ON-LEASH AREA RULES

Dogs are allowed on-leash in all public spaces, footways and reserves unless otherwise sign posted.

- Dogs must be under effective control by way of leash or cord by a competent person.
- Dogs must not rush at, or attack any person or animal (other than vermin).
- Dogs must not be within 10 metres of children's play equipment at any time.
- Dog walkers must pick up any faeces deposited by their dog immediately.

These rules are legislated under the
NSW Companion Animals Act 1998:
