
WHERE CAN I TAKE MY DOG IN BUNDEENA/ MAIANBAR?

Responsibilities for a person in control of a dog as per the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998.



DOG PROHIBITED AREAS

Dogs are not allowed in the following areas at any time. Penalties apply for non-compliance.

- The Royal National Park
- All Maianbar Foreshore Reserves (This area is a bird sanctuary for the protection of endangered bird species)
- Bonnie Vale (NPWS)

HORDERNS BEACH

- Warmer Months (September to April) No dogs allowed Weekends and Public Holidays
- ✓ Dogs allowed on-leash 8:30am to 4:30pm weekdays
- ☑ Dog allowed off-leash 4:30pm to 8:30am weekdays
- ▼ Colder Months (May to August) Dogs allowed off-leash anytime or day

GUNYAH BEACH

- Warmer Months (September to April) No dogs allowed 8:30am to 4:30pm
- ☑ Dogs allowed on-leash 4:30pm to 8:30am
- ✓ Colder Months (May to August) Dogs allowed on-leash anytime or day

OFF-LEASH AREA RULES

- All dogs must be accompanied and supervised by a competent person.
- All dogs must be able to be controlled without a leash, e.g., return to handler on command.
- Maximum of four (4) dogs per person.
- Dog walkers must remove all dog faeces that may be deposited by a dog under their control.
- Dog walkers are liable under the Companion Animals Act if their dog rushes at or attacks any person or animal (other than vermin).

ON-LEASH AREA RULES

Dogs are allowed on-leash in all public spaces, footways and reserves unless otherwise sign posted.

- Dogs must be under effective control by way of leash or cord by a competent person.
- Dogs must not rush at, or attack any person or animal (other than vermin).
- Dogs must not be within 10 meters of children's play equipment at any time.
- Dog walkers must pick up any faeces deposited by their dog immediately.
