Each year Sutherland Shire Council contributes \$500,000 towards supporting local not-for-profit initiatives through our Community Grants and Subsidies Program. This program provides vital financial backing to organisations that enhance the well-being and sense of social inclusion for local residents in need of support.

Making and impact

Last year we were delighted to support a diverse range of community groups, providing services ranging from social outings for local seniors to mental health support for young people at risk. All up, Council was able to support 39 local organisations, distributing grants of up to \$20,000 to assist in the delivery of 48 individual programs, each of which targeted a different area of need within our community. The applications received through this program highlight the incredible diversity of worthy initiatives which are championed by local people determined to make a difference.

Meeting with our grant recipients and hearing about the incredible work they do in our community is one of the real joys I get to experience in my role as Mayor. Each grant recipient is always so incredibly appreciative of the support they receive, and each have so many amazing stories to tell about the impact this funding has in furthering their efforts to provide support to those in need throughout the community.

But the incredible appreciation we receive from grant recipients only tells so much of the story. The real benefit of this program is the tremendous impact it has on the lives of all those who benefit, and I am blown away when I hear from the many local people for whom these programs make a real difference.
