Section 139 of the Roads Act 1993

Use this form to apply for approval to access fire trails and reserves associated works on private property and conditions to be set by Council. **We do not accept applications via facsimile or email.**

**Note:** This application will not be processed without payment of the application fee. The application fee covers initial site inspection, final site inspection and issuing of a key. There will be a separate fee, based upon the time the fire trail/reserve will be used by the applicant, for the license itself. Any additional inspections will incur additional fees in accordance with Councils adopted fees and charges.

You must apply at least 10 days prior to the intended date of access on the fire trail or through the reserve. Failure to provide all relevant information which is required as part of the application may result in the assessment of the application being delayed and/or the application being refused.
